Seatbelts

Under NSW Road and Maritime Authority (RMA) regulation, all passengers are obligated to wear seatbelts in any vehicles that are fitted with seatbelts. All passengers are to remain seated whilst the vehicle is in motion to maintain the safety of passengers on board. This includes tour guide, tour director and tour escort.

Child Restraints

Under NSW Road and Maritime Authority (RMA) regulation, child restraints are required to be fitted when carrying young children for vehicle less than 12 seats. Any vehicles larger than 12 Seats are not obligated to put children in the child restraints seat. Coach company can make a booking for child restraints if the prior arrangement is made at the time of booking at surcharge of \$10 per child restraint.

Food and beverage consumption:

Food & Beverages are not to be consumed on any vehicle without prior approval. In such circumstances payment of a bond may be required to cover the risk of damage to the vehicle. Your responsibility for any damage is in accordance with these terms and conditions.
